E589 Ololulung'a FGCK Child and Youth Development started in the year 2008. It is a non-profit organization that deals with elevating the lives of children, youths holistically so they can be responsible Christian adults. The project started after

The Child Survival Program was started back in November 2018. This program has since been running and the participants enrolled are doing very well. Campaigned against female genital mutilation, early marrieages, early pregnancies as well as harmfull cultural practices



In the heart of the Maasai community, deep-rooted cultural traditions have held sway for generations. Among these traditions, Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) has been one of the most challenging practices to confront as it was the only tradition regarded to transtion girls from

childhood to adulthood. However, in recent years, a glimmer of hope has emerged, thanks to the unwavering dedication of our church Full Gospel

Churches of Kenya and KE0589 F.G.C.K Child Development Center for coming up with an alternative right of passage for the girls where we have organized for camps and seminars where girls are engaged on life skills, spiritual nourishment, social development, rights



of a girl child and a ceremony is held afterwards to celebrate the transition from childhood to adulthood. Together, we became powerful partners, united by a common goal; to protect girl participants from

the risks and trauma associated with FGM. This could not have been possible without the unyielding support of the church leadership, stakeholders, and most importantly, the community itself. Their



willingness to embrace change and move away from this harmful tradition has transformed the lives of countless girls and young women. The



commitment to change, led by the church and KE0589, has borne remarkable fruits. The journey against FGM in our community is a testament to the power of faith, community, and the human spirit. Today, instances of FGM in the community are a rarity, and it stands as one

of the most significant milestones in our development center's projects. Furthermore, having witnessed the transformation in the community's perspective, our church is now advocating for a safer practice of circumcision for boys. Instead of clinging to outdated cultural practices that may put their health at risk, the church encourages the community to opt for hospital-based circumcisions. This shift is already gaining traction and promises a healthier future for

5 ome years back, education was perceived to be attainable to the few priviledged in the society. Children would undergo through the informal cultural education where they were taught on their traditions. And as formal education gained momentum,



the community saw it as a necessity. Parents began educating their kids. However, the financial divide, cultural setback and poor backgrounds became inhibiting factors. Our participants come from unfavourable these backgrounds where financial capability

needed to foster education is indeed a stumbling block. The less fortunate had the passion to educate their kids but were financially unable. Then, KE589 FGCK CDYC chipped in as shoulder that became a spark light in the midst of total darkness; that kindled candles that are still shining. And to date, the needy have been able to cross-over bridge of financial challenges, retrogressive culture and poor family backgrounds have receive quality education. Many of them whom education seemed a mirage now have turned pages that at KE589 FGCK CDYC have no other option but capture these beautiful milestones. We are happy to see over 310 participants in transitioning from survival, montessori, pre-primary, lower primary, upper primary, juniour to senior secondary to college and to university studying well without fees challenges. We are delighted for these milestones and looking forward to see that participants are still working hard to achieve their set goals, dreams and ambitions.

Established a computer college that is fully operational...

lolulung'a Computer Training Center is a college at the center of our pride which was started back in 2016. The FCP saw a need to equip participants with ICT skills as a way of embracing technology to the digital generation.

Besides, the community within our locality

has been in dire need

of computing skills longago, as there is not even one college for that offers these ICT

skills around; and

we saw as an opportunity to venture in.

The college aims at training and equipping

the foundational and intermediate skills on ICT. Although the college is still at a tender age, it has been able to graduate

over 200 students. We are looking forward to

establish an ICT hub that will offer to embrace advanced ICT skills that will enable participants to survive the hustle, fit into the job environment and be innovative in a bid to improve their living

standards. Since the

current age is a digital

generation, we don't

want to be left behind but but soar higher and become the best ICT center in Narok South. The establishment of this college has and will benefit the participants, the

church and the community as a whole.

Equipped participants with manicure and pedicure skills...

When Corona came early 2020, all learning institutions were shutdown. All project programs were halted. Every event that had a gathering was prohibited. Our participants became idle for several months, at their homes. But when Corona began subsiding, we thought to equip the willing and passionate participants with manicure and

pedicure skills; bearing the untouched waters area hence it served to venture inaiming to be self-reliant and since unemployment in mind that these were within Ololulung'a as a good opportunity to empowering them financially independent is a major challenge to

The KE589 fraternity led by the Patron has so far held successful outreach within Ololulunga missions crusades, prayer camps, Vocational Bible Study (VBS) and youth camps. KE 589 has a dance crew which has competed up to the national levels. The dance crew has a YouTube channel @Ahadi G Dancers which is always updated by dance moves. KE 589 has participants who got skills in playing piano, guitar, drum sets and have also competed in different competitions and won most of the awards.



Health and Wellbeing

We have got a successful medical intervention for our beneficiaries. We have a successful medical intervention done for our beneficiaries from medical checkups, treatments to major surgeries.

Our beneficiaries have also been well equipped on practising of good health practises that will enable them live a healthy life.

The caregivers have also been empowered on the basics of visiting pre-natal clinics and have safe deliveries at the hospital.

We have had a good network with Ololulungá Sub-county Referral Hospital which has been within our reach and helped us in fulfilling our mandate in the health related issues.

Caregiver Economic Empowerment Inititative

A journey of a thousand miles starts with one step. A vision that was borne after a parents meeting



to ensure that the project mobilize resources to boost school fees payment of beneficiaries which was rising in a high rate. The project started in January 2018 with a total of Kshs.125, 350 that was contributed by caregivers. The first lot of seven steers were purchased totalling Kshs.119, 800/= on the 23rd of January 2018. There was a top up from E-45 towards the steers where 5 steers worth Kshs.94, 500/= were bought. After the

steers stayed at different caregivers households for a period of nine months they were sold and a total of Kshs.290,500/= was got against Kshs.214,000/= which had been channelled towards the project. Profit proceeds from the first sale was Kshs 60,300/=.So far a total of Kshs. 274,400 was got from the sales and banked. Second lot of 16 steers were purchased on 19 of March 2019 costing a total of Kshs.267,000/=. The initiative got boosting from a funded proposal from CKE where the project got Kshs.800, 000. The ASM members, caregivers and staff strategized and came up with the best way to put the funds in good use

to expand the steers project .A total of Kshs.752, 750 was used to purchase thirty one steers at an average of Kshs.24,000/=.A land was leased of 72 acres to feed the steers for 4. Injection was also done to the steers by qualified animal health officer. The Vet also has time to administer drugs to sickly animals and advice on the best management practices.






